Agenda Briefing (Feb. 9, 2015)

- Agreed to replace underground electrical wiring on the Greenway.
- Town Manager to draft policy for approving Parks and Greenways amenities.

Regular Meeting (Feb. 12, 2015)

- Ratified Resolution supporting NC's Historic Preservation Tax Credit Programs.
- Approved Resolution adopting Iredell-Rowan Hazard Mitigation Plan for Town.
- Approved Final Adjusting Change Order (Amended) for Richardson Greenway Ext. North, Segment B.
- Adopted Ordinance changing zoning classification of 386 Murdock from Suburban Residential to Heavy Industrial.
- Approved MOU with Board of Education for SIHS Greenway cost sharing.
- Approved purchase of 22 Christmas wreaths for Greenway.

Annual Retreat (Feb. 20, 2015)

- Awarded construction contract in amount of \$684,820.46 to Davis Grading, Inc. for Weathers Creek Sewer project.
- Agreed to accept roads at the Charles Center into Town's roadway system.

Barium Springs Home for Children

• 156 Frazier Loop
Statesville, NC 28677

- Founded in Charlotte in 1883 by two Presbyterian women and stayed through graduation.
- Originally called Presbyterian Orphans Home
- Needs grew; more space was needed so land was purchased near site of legendary healing "Barium Springs."
- Until 1950s, children were mostly orphans, many who came as infants
- The Home once operated a farm, orchard, dairy, laundry, print shop and shoe repair shop.
- In 1950s, Barium began transitioning from an orphanage into a place of refuge for abused and neglected children.
- In 1969, daycare services were added.

- Later, an alternative school was founded for early middle to high school students
- Barium is committed to being a Critical Access Behavioral Health Agency that provides comprehensive, managed care to children and families.
- In 2014, Barium merged with Grandfather Homes for Children and now serves more than 3,500 children annually.
- Corporate headquarters are at the Barium Springs campus.

LEAF AND LIMB COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- The annual leaf & limb schedule is available at Town Hall.
- Take leaves and limbs to the curb in front of your house the day **BEFORE THE FIRST COLLECTION DAY**. If they are not out before the crew comes through, they will not be picked up.
- Put leaves and limbs in separate piles.
- Only limbs under **4"** inches in diameter will be collected.
- Limbs will not be picked up if they have been cut by professional tree cutters or trimmers.
- DO NOT** put leaves or limbs in bags.
